

## Araluen Botanic Park

### Introduction to the Spread Sheet: Camellias by Cultivars - Version 1. - 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019

**Cultivars by alphabetical order:** A '?' indicates some doubt about the name. There are a number of camellias where the cultivar name is currently unknown

*Species* including the most common species, a few true species and those in hybrids

**Area code and individual number** for identifying and locating each camellia. The areas are on the accompanying plan and each garden area has at least one board with a plan and list of the adjacent camellias

**Flower shape and colour:** brief information to confirm identification

**Origin and date:** Origin in an Australian state, and other Countries. Date of commercial availability. This information was mostly obtained from the International Register of Camellias. Camellias originating in California have been specially noted among those from the USA for their suitability in a Mediterranean climate

**Comments:** any additional information, including the names of known Western A

**Registration:** Listed on the International Register for Camellias as at April 2019. Those not included are true species; unknowns; some commercially available cultivars not registered; and some cultivars and seedlings local to Western Australia that have not been registered

**Old Code 1999/2000:** This refers to the historic codes used by Trevor France, a Friend of Araluen Botanic Park, who drew plans showing the camellias in the Park during 1999/2000. These old codes are no longer in use but the plans and notes provide an invaluable record of the camellias planted during the 1990s in the early years of the redevelopment of the Park

**Donations before 1999 and after 2001:** Many people have contributed by donating camellias to the collection and these people have been acknowledged from the records compiled by Trevor France for prior to 2000, and from information from Park staff particularly Grant Nixon, for subsequent donations. My apologies if anyone has been overlooked

**NOTE: Future Planting:** This list, as at 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019 does not include the additional camellias obtained during 2019. When these camellias have been verified, planted, coded and mapped they will be added to a future version of the spread sheet
